Greetings Karen & Ronnie,

Shannon and I hope this email finds you well, we sure do enjoy receiving the Club Newsletter and your pe-

riodic updates.

We saw in the Gazette that a great leadership team was elected. It is great to see all your activities, I share the club activities with our friends and neighbors and display it on our information desk here in the office. In our home village, have a car club and restoration shop just down the road from where we live... even British cars have a home in Germany. the shop has a wonderful restoration showroom with many cars on display for sale and club member driving. Klaus, the owner drives a Austin Healy with straight exhaust pipes venting before the rear wheels not the back bumper. The color is black on white. 



The Triumph TR250 was built for the North American market. Price pressures and tighter emission regulations resulted in twin Zenith-Stromberg carburettors being fitted instead of the TR5's Lucas fuel injection system. Otherwise it is nearly identical.

The TR250's engine delivered 111 bhp (81 kW), 39 bhp less than the TR5; 0–60 mph (0–97 km/h) acceleration took 10.6 seconds. The TR250 was also available with the Surrey Top system. In 1968, the TR250 sold in North America for approximately \$3,395, with wire wheels a \$118 option, overdrive \$175, and air conditioning \$395.

A total of 8,484 TR250s were built for the U.S market. Approximately 600 remain worldwide today, and many can now be found outside the United States, primarily in Europe. (Courtesy Wikipedia)
