OIL BURNING CARB

Does your Zenith Stromberg carburettor use oil? These carbs are not supposed to use oil and if yours does then you need to change the rubber "o" ring that is located at the bottom of the oil damper reservoir.

To replace this "o" ring, first remove the top of the carb. Then remove the piston. Now remove the carb's needle. From the bottom of the piston, insert a bolt (approx 3 to 4 inches long) and tap until the retainer, "o" ring, and needle adjusting screw fall out. To complete the repair job, insert the adjusting screw, new "o" ring and retainer. Push down on the retainer until it clicks into place and you are now finished. Replace the needle and piston and put the carb back together.

You will really see the difference this makes in the way your carb performs.
