





FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO ARE NEW TO BRITISH CARS, HERE IS HOW TO OBTAIN SPARES CATALOGUES. GO TO A MAGAZINE SHOP, LOOK IN THE BOOK FOR ADDRESSES, AND PURCHASE A FEW MAGAZINES ON BRITISH CARS. WITHIN THE PAGES ARE ADS. OF MANY SUPPLIERS FOR SPARES. DO NOT RULE OUT COMPANIES BASED IN ENGLAND BECAUSE YOU THINK THE PRICES WILL BE TOO HIGH.

AS AN EXAMPLE, THE WATER PUMP FOR AN MGC ENGINE IS HARD TO FIND HERE IN THE STATES AND SELLS FOR ATLEAST \$200.00 OR MORE. A BRITISH CATALOGUE LIST IT FOR 45 POUNDS OR LESS THAN 100.00 DOLLARS.

REMEMBER THAT PRICES ARE LISTED IN POUNDS AND NOT AMERICAN DOLLARS. THE BRITISH V.A.T., VALUE ADDED TAX, IS NOT APPLIED TO EXPORT SALES. SO IF IT IS INCLUDED IN THE SALES PRICE, CALCULATE THIS OUT AT 17.5% OF THE BASE PRICE. DO NOT ASK ME HOW TO DO THIS! I GIVE IT THE BEST GUESS TRY METHOD.

BE CAREFUL AFTER YOU BUY THESE MAGAZINES, YOU CAN GET HOOKED ON THEM!
