BACK ON THE ROAD

My '64 MG 1100 is back on the road again! The transmission has been rebuilt; the differential has new thrust washers, pinion shaft and seals; The engine has a new oil pump. The generator light no longer blinks on and off. The commutator has been serviced and a new set of brushes have been installed. The engine now sets in it's proper position with new mounts installed. Everything on the engine has been serviced if only to be cleaned and painted. I cannot seem to be able to just repair or service a component without cleaning it and painting it also.

It is sure nice to have first gear and a reverse which does not go thump, thump! The distance that the gear shift lever travels has been greatly reduced also. The lever does not almost touch the bottom of the dash tray now when in third gear.

The biggest problem with the transmission was caused by the lever which operates the shaft which chooses the which selector to operate. The lever on the exterior end of the shaft had been loose long enough to wear out the splines on both the shaft itself and the lever. By rebuilding a spare transmission, I was able to reduce the new parts needed. A new layshaft, six bearings, a seal and a gasket set were all that was necessary. Six bearings? Yes, remember this is a front wheel drive set up. The later version of the transmission uses a 7th bearing.

I did not have time to do a proper job with the engine bay. I am in the process of moving and getting the car readable again was the first priority.

So far so good. Although I did forget to reconnect the ground connection for the headlamps. On the good side, no oil leaks - yet!





The entire range of British made Smiths Instruments is now available exclusively from newly appointed U.S. distributor Brooklands Inc. These same instruments were used in many of the classic British sports cars and are perfect for restoration projects or those who are building replica vehicles. Smiths Instruments were the choice of manufacturers like AC Cars, Aston Martin, Austin Healey, Jaguar, MG, Rolls Royce, and Triumph. Today, they are still supplied as OE to Aston Martin, Jaguar, Rolls Royce and for the new MG V8.

These are the ORIGINAL British designed, developed and manufactured gauges, although present legal restrictions prevent the name 'Smiths' from appearing on instrument faces. The newly re-formed British manufacturer is working from the original Smiths drawings and specifications as well as using original Smiths tooling i.e. molds, dies etc.

Brooklands sells individual instruments or an economical complete set including all senders and voltage stabilizers. 18 different instruments are offered plus senders, bulbs, bulb holders and voltage stabilizers. The instruments are available with either chrome or black bezels. The 5 instrument set retails for \$399 and the 6 instrument set (with tachometer) for \$499.

Customers can also request a direct replacement Smiths Instrument for their specific vehicle - most of the vintage style instruments are available for cars dating from 1960 onwards.
