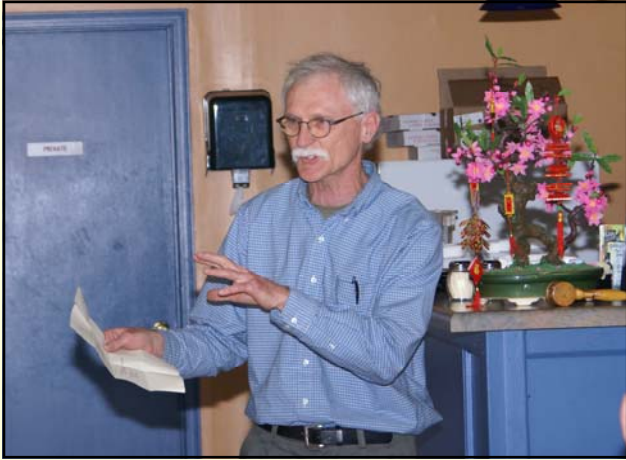

Joseph Cruthirds. Guest Speaker by Cathy Greensfelder



Our guest speaker for the February 26th meeting was Mr. Joseph Cruthirds. Joe is a full time faculty member, Professor and department head of the Motor Vehicle Technology Department at Delgado Community College's City Park Campus. He has a Masters of Education degree from Louisiana State University and is ASE Master Certified. He has worked with BMNCO for the past five years helping us coordinate our show.

Delgado serves local independent mechanic shops, dealerships, manufacturers' programs and non-automotive private industry. The school faces many challenges. Cars are getting more complex every year. Most faculty members teach for thirty years. There were no computers in cars when Joe started but now even the door handles have computers. Teachers must stay current in order to serve students, including hobbyists like us. Delgado's primary mission, however is to help young people make a career of auto mechanics.

Today's automotive technicians get paid by com-

mission. If no work comes in, there's no money. If a technician doesn't finish a job that day, there's no money. Make no mistake - good mechanics make good money, but it's a hard way to make a living, especially at first. It's also a big challenge to keep people in the profession long enough to reach the stage where they are making good money. An auto shop with ten mechanics needs two performance guys and eight maintenance mechanics. Delgado graduates need good prospects in a shop to stay in the business. They have a degree and a good background in electronics so they get picked up by Entergy, the FBI and local plants where they get a steady income and benefits. Perhaps there is something to learn from this.

In addition, the future of the business is uncertain. With the development of Hybrids and bio-fuel, electrics the industry will be transitioning away from the internal combustion engine over the next ten to fifteen years. One thing Delgado is doing to stay current is building a 6,500 square foot collision center. It will have fresh air systems, an evacuation system for fumes, a booth for prep work, etc.

Joe invites us all to come by and take a look at the facilities. Get involved with the college; take some courses. He would like us to tell him what they are doing right and what they are doing wrong and to support the young people. We have taken a big step by offering the first scholarships sponsored by a local group. Delgado's students work to stay in school and our \$500 will make a big difference to the recipients.



BMCNO Scholarship Presentation

This year will be BMCNO's eighteenth annual British Car Day. Five years ago the club moved the show from LaFreniere Park in Metairie to Delgado Community College – City Park Campus. We have donated the proceeds from the show to Delgado each year, buying shop supplies for the past two years to replace material destroyed by Katrina. However, from the very first year at Delgado, we wanted to give scholarships.

This year we finally did it!! Karen Murray joined the board last year. Karen is employed by the Jefferson Parish School District and has worked with the Bonnebel High School automotive program and has coordinating with Delgado on many other issues. She knew what needed to be done and who to contact. Karen got the scholarship committee organized, coordinated things with Delgado, cracked the whip a few time and FINALLY got a BMCNO scholarship program created.

On Tuesday, February 26, 2008 club President Keith Vezina formally presented the first BMCNO scholarships to five Delgado automotive department students. Steven Legendre II, Jeff Radosta, and Taiga Roof II were able to attend the meeting and a representative from the

Times Picayune photographed the presentation. William Gray and Ike Ntukogu, the two other scholarship recipients, were unable to attend. A check for 500 dollars has been deposited directly in each student's Delgado account to-



wards their tuition for the spring semester.

Congratulations to Steven, Jeff, Taiga, William and Ike. And congratulations to Karen and the rest of the scholarship committee for finally, after five years, bringing this about.

Corn and Crawfish Soup

2 cans cream of corn
 2 cans whole kernel corn (drained)

 1 bunch green onions chopped
 Pinch of celery chopped
 1 pound of crabmeat
 1 pt. of half & half (use however much you want to desired consistency)
 1 stick of butter
 White pepper to taste
 Tony Chachere's to taste

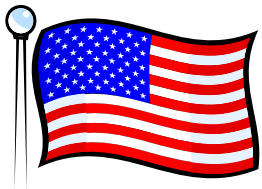

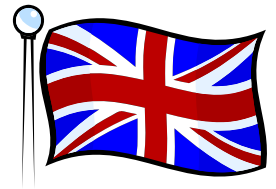
