The weather forecast is good for Saturday. As of today, we have \$950 in sponsorships, about \$200 in gift certificates, door prizes, etc.

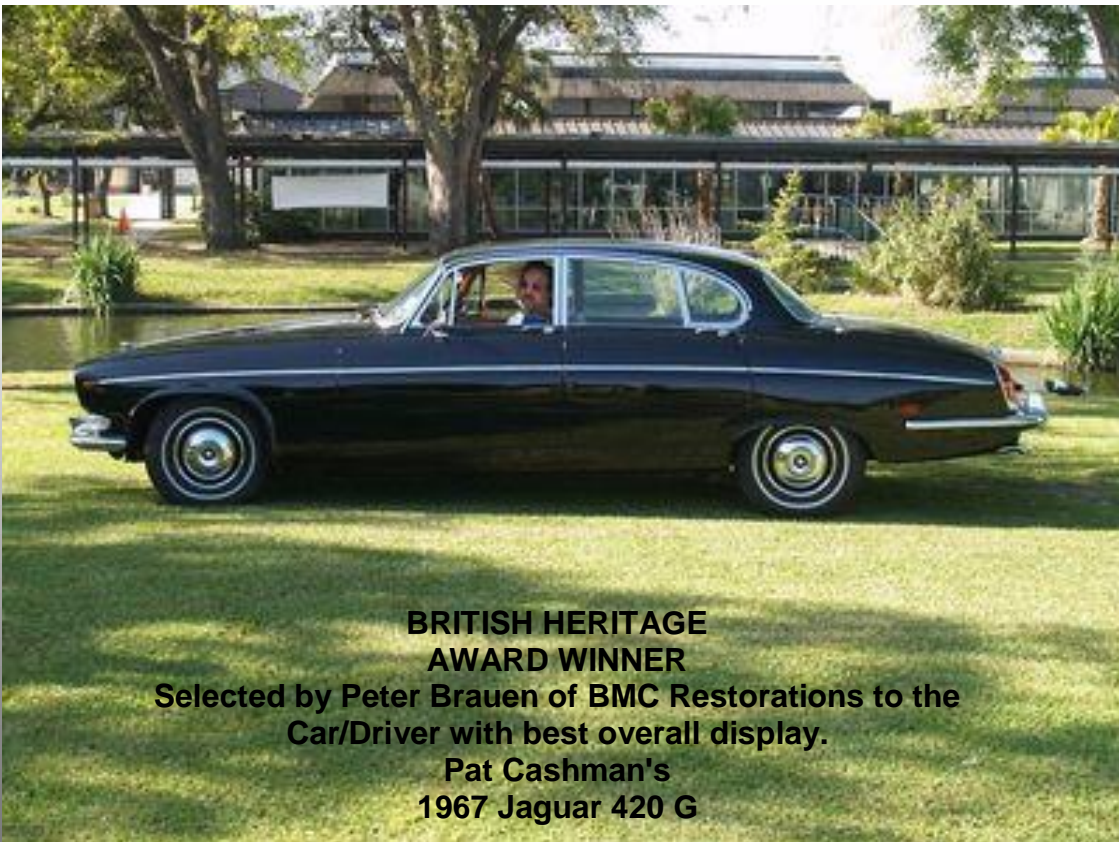

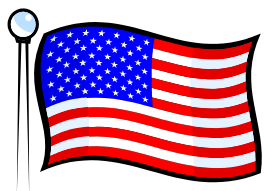

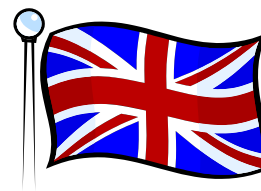
